Numbers delivered, receiving dates and selling prices taken from "Sirkulære fra Poststyrelsen/Poststyret" and the Stamp Bureau's accounts books. These books tell little about coupon types, concerning coupon designs they give more information however. It is impossible from these books to give exact info. For instance: The 23.03.1937 delivery of 45 øre coupons, was that type Lo 11 or Lo 12? I have only my own material helping me making the right judgement, and **I would appreciate your help very much** if you have any information.

Red letters = produced locally or sold by error (0 = philatelic?)

Blue type letters = in own collection (complete as delivered from UPU)
